Phi Delta Chi will also host its annual award program to name the 2008 Thurston Cup winner along with the other award recipients.





I am writing to update you on the tremendous success of the Saroyan Leadership Challenge to raise \$500,000 to endow Phi Delta Chi's Pharmacy Leadership & Education Institute (PLEI) in perpetuity. We are extremely pleased by the enthusiastic response from our Alumni Brothers to "get on board" the Challenge.

To date, 120 Brothers have donated or pledged over \$165,000 to our goal. Contributions by check, E-check and credit card continue to come in regularly, as we continue to move toward our goal. I am confident we will surpass \$200,000 in 2008, steadily on the way to reaching our five year goal of \$500,000.
