

This ChEQ visit was the weekend of March 4-7. It was a bit intimidating, although we were constantly reminded that the ChEQ visit is a good thing so the National Officers can visit a strong chapter (us) to see how we function to bring some new ideas to a chapter that may need some assistance. The ChEQ visit was not as stressful as we anticipated, as the National and Regional Officers were extremely pleased and impressed with how our Chapter processes. Our visitors even provided some constructive criticism as well as some pretty fair opportunities to improve in some areas.
