Founder's Day Luncheon - November 2nd, 2012

Founder's Day was celebrated at the College of Pharmacy by students and alumni. This year the Collegiate Chapter invited PDC staff from the college and hospital to attend the luncheon commemorating the date that the fraternity was founded in Ann Arbor, Michigan. On **November 2**, **1883**, eleven men at the University of Michigan formed the fraternity. At that time, there were a number of literary societies at Michigan, but Phi Delta Chi's founders believed something should be organized exclusively for the College of Pharmacy. A quotation from the early records reads: "Both students and faculty recognized that such an organization would bring students of pharmacy together for the discussion of scientific questions pertaining to pharmacy and its sister sciences."
