The Compounding Corner

Is it ethical or fraud?

A commercial formulation is now available in some states that contain capsaicin, lidocaine, menthol, and methyl salicylate for topical use in treating neurologic pain. This same formulation can be compounded by a pharmacist and, with existing price formulations used by most insurers, cost the patient or insurer about \$125 per 4 ounce bottle. The commercial formulation has an Average Wholesale Price (AWP) of ~\$350 to \$400 for 4 ounces. However, if purchased in quantity, a case of 50 bottles runs only \$60 a bottle [\$3,000/case]. Should one pass on the savings to the patient and his/her insurer when buying in quantity and price the prescription at \$125 or use the AWP and charge \$350?

I would suggest that if one receives a lot of prescriptions for this product to buy in bulk and pass on the cost savings to the patient and/or the insurer by charging \$125/4 ounces. However, if one does not receive enough prescriptions to use the bulk provided quantity, then buy the single item and price the prescription using the AWP. It is probably not fraudulent to buy the item by the case and charge the AWP but it would seem unethical not to pass on the price savings. After all, our profession prides itself in finding ways to cut health costs and provide the professional with a living wage.
