## **The Compounding Corner**

#### Hygroscopic versus deliquescent drug compounding

Similar problems arise when compounding a hygroscopic drug or a deliquescent drug. Hygroscopic means that the drug takes up water from the atmosphere and will likely become tacky or even dough like from taking up the moisture. A deliquescent drug takes up so much moisture from the atmosphere that it actually dissolves in the water that it is absorbing [taking up into] or adsorbing [attracting onto the surface]. In order to compound a capsule or powder paper formulation of drugs with this physical chemical property one needs to use a desiccant like microcrystalline cellulose or silica gel as an additive. The desiccant should be weighed out first, placed in a glass mortar and triturated first. Then add the drug, triturate to homogeneity and fill the capsules or weigh out the powders to make papers. The dosage forms then need to be packaged in moisture proof containers and stored under 30°C.

There are a variety of desiccants that one may use: microcrystalline cellulose, silica gel and povidone K25 are commonly used in compounding and in the pharmaceutical industry. One might also try anhydrous citric acid or light magnesium oxide provided not too much magnesium oxide is needed and one sees a laxative effect from using too much of the magnesium salt as a desiccant.
