

The Passing of a Pharmaceutically Elegant Person — Dr. Fred Siegel —

In Memory of Our Beloved Dr. Frederick Siegel.

This last December 15th 2013 Dr. Frederick Siegel passed. He was a wonderful teacher and many of us have fond memories of him and his classes. He taught Pharmaceutics/Pharmacy at the UIC COP for almost 35 years (from 1958 to 1992) and was awarded with nine Golden Apple Awards and fifteen Teacher of the Year Awards. His rabbi called him a true mensch. A mensch is literally a "person who is responsible, has a sense of right and wrong and is the sort of person other people look up to". It is also a person with great humility and love for his fellow man. Dr. Fred Siegel was all of that. We loved his lectures which were done without notes and were always a mix of facts we needed to remember and humor that helped us to remember those facts. He will be sorely missed. Dr. Siegel was a friend to all students and the Phi Delta Chi loved him dearly. Many have contributed to the Siegel Scholarship which is now endowed in perpetuity but additional donations would increase the amounts that could be given to students. 
