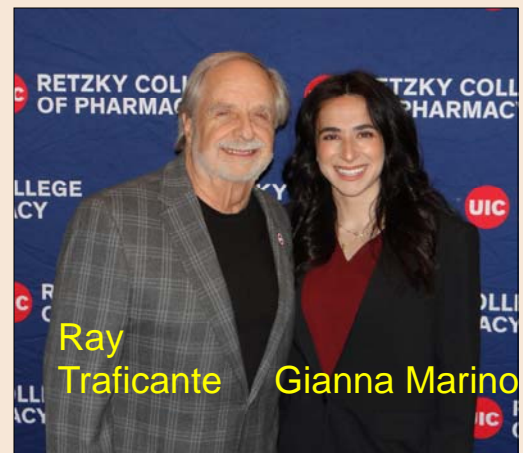
UIC Phi Delta Chi Memorial Scholarship 2025 Recipients
