Recently, COX-2 inhibitors have been in the news regarding potential cardiovascular adverse reactions. A meta-analysis published in JAMA (JAMA 2001;268:954-9) by Mukherjee and colleagues analyzed data involving 18 000 patients found a significant increase in cardiac events in patient receiving COX-2 inhibitors compared to patients receiving placebo in an aspirin meta-analysis. These findings raise concerns that COX-2 inhibitors are prothrombotic. Individual trials included in the Mukherjee meta-analysis revealed that patients receiving rofecoxib (Vioxx) experienced significantly more cardiac events than patients receiving naproxen did. This finding raises the possibility that traditional NSAIDs may have antiplatelet activity. However, it is too soon to jump to major conclusions based on the meta-analysis. Further prospective trials are needed.
