

If coming from Chicago follow these directions: Get on I-88 (Toll Road) and Exit I-88 at Winfield Road - North. Then drive 1.5 miles to Butterfield Rd. (Hwy 56) AND turn left onto Butterfield Road.

Drive two blocks to the park entrance on the right.

The retreat begins promptly at **9:30 AM** at the **NORTH SHELTER**. (If you are using "Google Maps" to guide you, make sure to **enter the** destination as the <u>Blackwell Forest Preserve North Shelter</u>)
