Our Alumni Chapter has reserved a **shelter** at the Hidden Lake Forest Preserve in Downers Grove. Officers from the Collegiate and Alumni Chapters will be getting together for the retreat. The **park entrance is on IL-Route 53 just south of Butterfield Road**. If Driving from Chicago via I-88: Exit I-88 at Route 53 North (right turn from exit ramp). Then drive 1.7 miles north to the preserve entrance on the right. (across the street from Walmart) Consult Google Maps for the best directions.

The **retreat** is scheduled to begin promptly at **9:30 AM** at the large modern shelter that you will see on your left when entering the preserve.

Refreshments for the meeting and lunch will be provided by the Alumni Chapter. Burgers, Dogs and Brats will be cooked by "Chef Ron" and "Chef Ray". There will also be and side dishes galore, water and assorted sodas.

(Alcoholic drinks are not allowed in the park)

Alumni are invited to participate in the Collegiate Chapter Retreat or just attend the **picnic lunch** at approximately **12:30 PM**.

The 2nd Annual “Pharm Party” INFORMATION

Family and friends are welcome to spend the day and evening at “**Paul’s Pharm Party**” starting at NOON, August 29th !

LOCATION: 8543 E. Twin Bridges Road

Warren, IL. 61087 (use Google Maps)

The town of Warren is near the Wisconsin border. This is a **two hour drive from Chicagoland**.

It’s recommended that anyone attending the party stay overnight. Paul is offering to provide shelter in his home and his “pop-up” camper on Saturday night. The lower level bedroom has a queen sized bed and a private bathroom. The main level “bunk” room is a Double/Queen with a shared bathroom.

The air conditioned camper contains 2 Queen sized beds. If you are interested in these accommodations, it’s on a “**first to reserve**” basis.

(**NOTE:** Bring your own sleeping bag for the camper)

Paul also has ONE RV-ELECTRIC HOOK-UP available if someone wants to bring their RV. There is also plenty of room for camping overnight. Electric can be provided for tent campers. **HOTEL INFO:** There is a [Country Inn & Suites](#) in nearby Stockton, IL. It’s about 15 minutes south of Paul’s home. Families may like to come a day earlier to enjoy the sights in and around the town of [Galena](#).(20 minutes from hotel)

- (1) Bring a cooler ! Bring extra bottles of water and most importantly a bag of ice. (available at the gas station in Warren)
- (2) Bring your own soft drinks, beer, alcoholic favorites along with snacks. (Optional dish to share, but please check with Paul)
- (3) If you are camping, bring an extension cord for possible electric hook-up. (Paul has a few extension cords)
- (4) Very Important...Bring chairs for those attending!
- (5) If you plan on fishing, bring a pole. (Paul has a few you can use)

What is Provided:

- Chef Paul will be preparing his “world famous” Brisket and Pulled Pork for the event. He also has a pizza oven to prepare made to order pizza, if MEAT is not your only love in life. Side dishes, desert and snacks.
- Acres of land for everyone to enjoy. How about a “cornhole” tournament? There is also a 2 acre pond that Paul has stocked for fishing. Bring a pole if you wish to test your luck !!
- Water will be provided, but it’s best to bring extra from home.
